In order to get a good quality product and avoid breaking machines, the fiber being fed through a wool mill needs to be good quality and as free of contaminants as possible, that is to say properly sorted and skirted. The most efficient time to skirt and sort fiber is at shearing time. Every incoming fleece will be checked for quality, and if it has not been properly skirted, we will skirt it at a rate of \$50/hr. Any contaminants that could damage the machines such as anything metal, hoof trimmings, wood chips or sticks, and cockleburs will lead to the fleece being rejected or thoroughly skirted, with time invoiced for. *Any evidence of moths will lead to fleece being entirely rejected.* We assume that, if a fleece is weak but still processable you are aware of the quality concerns and want us to process the fleece to the best of our ability.

Longwools and double coated fleeces often need a small amount of crimp wool added to them to process well on our equipment. We will do our best to add as little as possible to get it to process well.

Yarn comes packaged in 4 ounce hanks by default. We're happy to package in different size hanks or on cones as a special order.

When working with your fiber, we are happy to help select the best finished product for your intended use and the fiber you have. Please don't hesitate to ask if you have any questions at all.
